### Abbreviations and Acronyms explained:

Abbreviation/Acronym	Meaning
<b>DSA 1</b>	Letter sent by the funding authority informing of acceptance of application for DSA
<b>DSA 2</b>	Letter sent by the funding authority informing of approval of DSA funded support (Notification of Entitlement)
<b>EU Student</b>	Student whose home address is in a country which is within the European Union
<b>Home Student</b>	Student whose home address is in a country which is within the UK
<b>NHS Disabled Student's Allowance</b>	DSA funded support for students studying on some NHS-funded courses
<b>NAR</b>	Needs Assessment Report
<b>NAC</b>	Needs Assessment Centre
<b>LSP</b>	Learning Support Plan (specific to the University of Lincoln)

# Study Your Way with DSA

## Additional Information About Eligibility

**Eligibility for DSAs also depends on other factors such as on which course you are studying:**

- **If you are a home student and have a diagnosis of an impairment, health condition (including a mental health condition), or Specific Learning Difference like dyslexia, you may be entitled to claim DSAs.**
- **If you are a postgraduate student funded by a research council. You may also find the Research Councils UK website on Disabled Students' Allowances useful.**

## Additional Information About Eligibility

**You cannot obtain DSAs from Student Finance England if you are:**

- **An EU student or an International student**
- **Eligible for NHS Disabled Students' Allowances (this is a separate scheme) Follow this link:**

- **Getting equivalent support from another funding source, like from your university or a social work bursary**
- **A postgraduate student from Ireland**
- **For students who live in Scotland, Northern Ireland or Wales, or if you are living offshore but within the British Isles such as the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man, you should follow the links to your own funding authorities listed above.**
