Are you eligible for the Foyer/Supported Housing Bursary?

- You must be a 'Home' student, which is determined by the funding provider (e.g. Student Finance England) and not the student status that University of Lincoln allocates to you.
- You must have come directly to University from living in a Foyer or other supported housing, where you have lived between the ages of 16 to 18.
- You must be studying for a first undergraduate degree at the University of Lincoln or, having completed an undergraduate degree at the University of Lincoln, be continuing on to a postgraduate degree with us. Applicants studying for a postgraduate degree with the University of Lincoln who have studied elsewhere, or have taken a break between study levels will be considered on an individual basis.
- EU students and International Students cannot apply.
- If you are studying on a **part-time basis** your course intensity must be at least 25% of a full-time equivalent.

Who administers the Foyer / Supporting Housing bursary?

- Each year the Foyer Federation informs the University of any students who intend to enrol directly from living in a Foyer.
- These bursaries are then administered by the Student Funding Team and funded through the University of Lincoln Financial Assistance Funds.
- There is no guarantee of a payment for any applicant, so please do not rely on this bursary as a guaranteed form of income.

When can you make an application?

- You can apply for the Foyer / Supported Housing Bursary at any point of time throughout the academic year, but we would recommend you apply as soon as possible after enrolment.

How much will you get?

- The total award per year is £1,000 which is paid in 3 termly instalments (subject to attendance checks).
- If you are a part-time student, you will be paid pro-rata for the academic year.

How often do you have to apply?

- Students should apply each year; evidence is only required with your first application.

Our procedures:

- Applications are assessed in order of receipt.
- Where applications are incomplete or extra evidence is required, you will be contacted to supply that evidence. Your application will not be assessed until we have a complete application.
- **We will contact you via your University email address so please check it regularly.**
- We will contact you with the decision on this application within 4 weeks.
- Any bursary will be paid directly into the account details you provide.
- The funders of the Foyer/Supported Housing Bursary (the University of Lincoln) will be provided with statistical information relating to awards made.
