Are you eligible for the Gender Expression Fund?

- You must be registered (enrolled) as a University of Lincoln student.
- Identify as trans, non-binary, intersex or otherwise gender diverse.
- Have reasonable need for items or transport expenses to be covered by the fund.
- Not be requesting funding for medical treatment (such as hormone therapy or surgical procedures) or to fund private counselling/therapy.

Who administers the Gender Expression Fund?

- This fund is administered by the Student Funding Team, which is part of Student Support & Advice. It is funded through the University of Lincoln Financial Assistance Funds.
- There is no guarantee of a payment for any applicant, so please do not rely on an award as a guaranteed form of income.

When can you make an application?

- You can apply for the 2023/24 Gender Expression Fund from when it opens on 23rd October 2023 until 31st May 2024. Funds are limited - we would recommend you apply as soon as possible after it opens for application.

How much will you get?

- We anticipate most eligible applicants will receive a maximum of £100. Where need is greater applicants may be directed to make an application to the University's Term Time Fund, if eligible.

How often do you have to apply?

- Students may apply once each academic year.

Our procedures:

- Applications are assessed in order of receipt.
- We will contact you with the decision on this application within 4 weeks.
- Any award will be paid directly into the bank account details supplied.

Confidentiality & Data Protection:

- Applications are seen only by relevant staff and will be treated as strictly confidential. The University of Lincoln is a data controller under the terms of the 2018 Data Protection Act. The Student Funding Team follows University policy in matters of data protection. The data requested in this form is covered by the notification provided by the University under the Data Protection Act. Personal data will be used solely in the Department for statistical purposes and electronic record keeping.
- The funders of the Gender Expression Fund (the University of Lincoln) will be provided with statistical information relating to awards made – no personal details will be shared.
